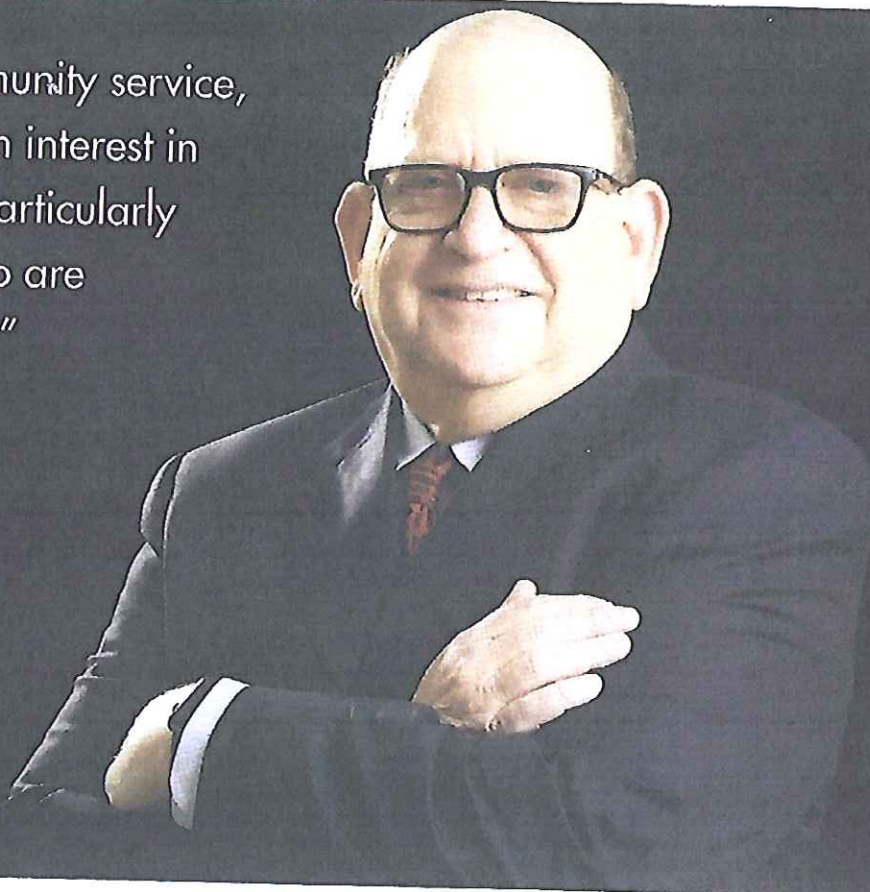


LEADERSHIP IN LAW

dramatically increase the amount of food distributed," he said. "The beneficiaries were the hundreds of food pantries, soup kitchens and direct service providers feeding thousands of hungry Marylanders."

Fedder has a history of helping people in need. After earning a bachelor's degree from the University of Maryland, Baltimore County in 1972, he worked as a resource teacher in the Baltimore school system while attending the University of Baltimore School of Law at night. He earned his law degree in 1977.

He has served on the boards of ARC of Baltimore, which helps adults with developmental disabilities; the Middle Grades Partnership, which partners middle school and private school students together to help the middle-schoolers get placed in the city's most competitive high schools; and the SEED School of Maryland, a charter college preparatory boarding school for children in need in grades six through 12.
